## Who is IIUSA?

Invest in the USA (IIUSA), is the national 501(c)(6) not-for-profit membership- based trade association for the EB-5 Regional Center industry. IIUSA is the unifying voice for thousands of diverse stakeholders advocating to keep EB-5 investment and job creation a vital component of the U.S. economy.

## What is EB-5?

- An economic development program responsible for billions of dollars in U.S. economic stimulus
- A job creation catalyst for hundreds of thousands of American workers
- A source of low-cost capital that provides funding for a variety of critical projects
- A targeted investment tool for infrastructure projects and high unemployment and rural areas



## What Is An Allied Partner?

An Allied Partner is an organization that benefits from EB-5 investment dollars but is not a traditional IIUSA member.
